About the Course

The Visual Arts course aims to foster interest and enjoyment in making and experiencing Art in from a broad range of sources, times, and methods. Students build informed points of view about Artists and their work, develop critical thinking skills in Art Analysis while developing a portfolio of artworks that explores their own ideas, passions, and interests through traditional and experimental art-making. What You Will Do

You will produce a portfolio of artworks using at least two methods including painting, drawing, printmaking, sculpture or photography, and digital media, installation, ceramics, etc. You will develop autonomy in Art making, producing a Body of Work during the year in their own chosen style, method, and topic, and continue to use a VAPD to assist in building their own Art practice.

Future Opportunities

Students are well prepared to continue their creative studies at University in -Visual Arts, Graphic Design, Architecture and Product design, and Art therapy. Further studies are also available through TAFE in Visual Arts, Design, Cartooning, Advertising Illustration and Photography, Floristry, Hair and Beauty, Landscape, Fashion, and Interior Design.
